# Finance support - Cardiff Council

Support for maximizing income is available through Cardiff Council's advisory services.

One avenue for assistance is the Advice Line at 02920 871071, which provides guidance on various issues, including income maximization through the Money Advice team. Upon contacting the Advice Line, relevant details are gathered, and individuals are directed to the appropriate team, who will schedule a callback based on the urgency of the matter. For those preferring in-person assistance, the Money Advice Service operates from the Central Library Hub, supplemented by outreach services at various locations listed on the website under "Contact us - Cardiff Money Advice Service."

Moreover, the Money Advice Service encompasses the Disability Benefit Support Team, specializing in aiding individuals with Child Disability Living Allowance, Attendance Allowance, Limited Capability for Work under Universal Credit, Personal Independence Payment, and Carer's Allowance. They also offer support with completing mandatory reconsiderations, appeals, and representation at Tribunal hearings when necessary. To access this service, individuals can reach out via the advice line or email at disabilitybenefitsupport@cardiff.gov.uk, which operates by appointment only, accommodating face-to-face or home visits as needed.

Furthermore, residents can conduct a "better off" assessment using one of the recommended online Benefits calculators featured on the Gov.uk website: Benefits calculators - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk).






Vale Family Information Service has achieved the Families First Quality Award.
